Who is Scottish Love in Action?

Scottish Love in Action (SLA) is a charity based in Scotland that cares for and supports vulnerable and destitute children in India. We feed, clothe, house, educate and provide medical care for over 560 children by providing funding to a grass roots non-governmental organisation (NGO) partner who run two Home-cum-Schools in Tuni and Hyderabad, both in the State of Andhra Pradesh, south-east India.

How do I get started?

Holding a Girlguiding Bake a Little Love event couldn't be easier. Here's how it works:



-  Contact the SLA Office to register your Unit and to request a Bake a Little Love starter pack which includes flyers, a cookie cutter, invites, recipes and a donation form to help you and your girls get organised for your Bake a Little Love Event.
-  Alternatively if you are able to download the resources from the SLA website and print them off yourself this will save SLA the printing costs. If you do get your resources this way do still remember to contact us so we can send you your free cookie cutter and register your Unit into the Bake a Little Love prize draw.
-  Organise a date in February to hold your Bake a Little Love Event. Give each of your girls some baking recipes and a sheet of invites so they can invite family and friends to help indulge in the delicious array of baked goods.
-  Time for everyone to get out their mixing bowls and bake their hearts out! Make some heart shaped cookies, buns or cakes. Remember to have plenty of pink food colouring and sprinkles for that extra sweet touch!
-  Price and display your heart themed delights and open the door to guests so they can indulge to their heart's content.
-  Record your event by taking photos of your culinary treats and send them into us for our website.
-  Complete your Unit's donation form and send a cheque to SLA for the amount raised.
-  Give yourselves a big pat-on-the back for helping spread a little love to the children of SLA.
