Volunteer Groups go each year July/August and November/December

Cost: excluding international flights, insurance, visa.

£1200, including:

- All accommodation in India
- All food and water
- All internal travel
- £500 contribution to the cost of the project and work of our partners



We request that volunteers undertake additional fundraising to contribute to SLA's core mission of caring for the children's essential needs.

Our first two volunteer groups raised **£29,000**, enough to educate **345** children for an entire year.

How Do Expeditions Work?

Group trips of 8-14 team members

Open to anyone aged 18 to 75

Lasting two working weeks

Requiring no specialist skills,
just enthusiasm and
basic fitness



The purpose of these projects are to work with our partners and make an immediate difference to the children in our care, and to have enormous fun while doing it!

You could be taking part in English conversation classes, arts and crafts workshops, and helping to organise sports and outdoor activities. Volunteers arrive with a sense of common purpose and leave feeling they have made a positive contribution to the lives of the children supported by our partners.”
