Hear this: More than one in three girls in rural Telangana (Maheshwari's home) become child brides (National Family Health Survey-4). UNICEF reports that 1 in 3 of the world's child brides are in India.

...I will get an education

Kalpana never felt the need for education. She worked as a domestic servant with her mother. VOICE 4 Girls helped to change her mind: "VOICE made me realise the importance of staying in school and getting a degree. I know if I study hard now, I can earn for my family later." After returning to school, Kalpana learned leadership skills from VOICE 4 Girls, supported younger girls and now plans to speak to her village about the importance of education.

Hear this: Women with secondary school education earn almost twice as much as those with no education (World Bank). An Indian girl with 10 years of education is six times less likely to be forced into an illegal early marriage than a girl with no education (UNICEF India).

...I will resist abuse

When **Laxmi's** neighbour started sexually harassing her she knew it was wrong but was too scared to speak up. She told a VOICE 4 Girls counsellor who encouraged her to tell her parents. They did not believe her but VOICE helped Laxmi find the words to convince her parents she was being abused. "Without VOICE 4 Girls I wouldn't have known what was happening to me," she says. "I am going to talk about sexual abuse and other violence to girls like me so that they understand how to protect themselves".

Hear this: In rural Telangana, almost half of women aged 15-49 who have been married have suffered spousal violence. (National Family Health Survey-4). One in five adolescent girls in India fear physical assault when in public (Save the Children).

Too many girls in India are not as fortunate as Maheshwari, Kalpana and Laxmi. Too many suffer in silence because they have little or no control over their bodies or their futures.



VOICE 4 Girls helps girls resist being forced to do things against their will and helps them take control of their futures by:

- teaching them about reproductive and sexual health, their rights, how to recognise, prevent and report abuse
- giving them negotiation skills, enabling them to resist becoming child brides, child workers or victims of abuse

- teaching them life skills such as future planning and building their confidence
- encouraging them to become Sakhis peer leaders – and to share what they have learnt with their schools, families and communities
- VOICE also educates boys, teaching them the empathy and respect for girls and women that is critical to bring lasting change.

Since 2016, SLA has partnered with VOICE 4 Girls to help 6,600 girls find their voices. We were delighted that we secured a BBC Radio 4 Charity Appeal on International Women's Day 2020 to promote the work of us and our partner VOICE 4 Girls.
