what do we do?

Scottish Love in Action work with local partners in India to empower vulnerable children and young people to change their lives.

Our partners provide the highest quality of care and education. For over 20 years we have created generational change for the most vulnerable, giving them the tools to break free from poverty and transform their lives, families and communities for years to come.

We currently fund, support and work with three projects.

ASRITHA Rainbow Home, in the city of Hyderabad, rescues and rehabilitates children aged 5-8. They provide comprehensive care, including nutrition, healthcare, education and life-skills, for 100 girls in a safe, welcoming and supportive environment.

Livelihood Project, in the cities of Hyderabad, Delhi and Bangalore, provides tailored Life Skills and Vocational Training to 600 young people aged 16-23 each year, as they transition from living at Rainbow Homes to living independently. The project aims to equip them to take control of their futures and ensure they reach their full potential.

VOICE 4 Girls, in the state of Telangana, breaks the cycle of poverty through education, mentoring and training for vulnerable adolescent girls. Voice educates girls about their bodies, their health and their human rights, through activity-based camps. They empower girls to stay in school and to resist early marriage, childbirth and child labour. Our funding for VOICE 4 Girls has helped over 6000 girls.





how can you help?

We are very grateful for any and all donations. We encourage, where possible, regular giving as it provides us with the security of a steady income and allows us to plan accordingly.

Below are some examples of what your money can do:

£3 provides 1 month's healthcare for 1 child at Rainbow Homes

£10 enables a young person to access 6 'job-readiness' sessions through the Livelihoods Project

£15 provides 1 month's food for 1 child at Rainbow Homes

£36 enables three girls to attend a 10-day education and empowerment camp at VOICE 4 Girls

Bhavani's Story

Bhavani came to ASRITHA Rainbow Home when she was six years old. She used to live on the streets and would beg with her mother.



After she came to the Home, her mother would visit her twice a month. However, her mother stopped coming and after a few weeks the Home's social worker went to find her, only to discover that she had died.

Bhavani has no other family. She will be cared for and looked after by the staff at the Home until she is 18. She is settled and happy, doing well at school and has made lots of friends. Bhavani is being empowered to change her life and now has a brighter future ahead.
