Amulya had to fight against the damaging cultural belief that girls can only make a living through marriage

To stop her teenage cousin's marriage, Amulya* had to fight against the cultural belief that girls can only make a living through marriage.

This was a struggle, as her cousin's critically ill parents believed that their daughter's marriage would ensure her welfare. They believed that, when they died, only marriage would give Amulya financial security and a bright future.

Amulya was so thankful for our local partner, VOICE 4 Girls, where she learned how child marriage can be negative for a girl. She learned about being a leader and how to support girls facing similar challenges to her.

The experience gave Amulya the courage she needed to approach her Dad about her cousin's marriage, to share what she had learned, and to persuade him to adopt her cousin. Following conversations with her dad, her cousin's parents eventually agreed to call off the wedding!













At SLA our mission revolves around the pillars of Provide, Protect, and Prepare. We work to create a ripple effect that breaks the chains of poverty, giving children and young people the foundations for a future filled with promise and opportunity.

Provide

We work to help vulnerable children to thrive. Our community-focused programmes prioritise family support, addressing basic needs and facilitating access to education. By providing children and young people with the skills and tools they need, we break the generational cycle of poverty, fostering environments where children can thrive within their own homes.

Protect

For children who find themselves without a home or family support, we work to ensure they have the best possible levels of care and protection. We work with a children's home to provide the best possible care, and provide community support to those who are extremely vulnerable. Our dedication to protection extends beyond physical safety, encompassing emotional well-being, a nurturing environment, and essential skills development.

Prepare

Our support initiatives are designed to equip young people with the tools they need to break free from the cycle of poverty. Through targeted training, life skills development, and personalised mentoring, we prepare them for the future.

Our goal is to help them recognise their own confidence, resilience, and build a sense of purpose, ensuring that every child has the chance to shape their own destiny.



Promoting Your Event

Use your socials

Share your fundraising page with your friends and family on Facebook and Instagram, and with colleagues on LinkedIn.

Publicity

Use our poster with blank space for details to advertise your event.

Ask to advertise in your local magazine or church/faith group/community newsletter.

Let us know the details of your event and we can share it on our social media

Set a target

Get others excited by setting a target and sharing your progress with them.

Photos

Take photos during preparations and share as a reminder for your event.

Make sure to get photos on the day and send them to us.

Thank your supporters

Remember to thank people who sponsor you, donate or attend your event.

Be Legal and Safe

Use the right language

promoting your fundraising.

Let people know you're fundraising in aid of SLA

Let people know you are fundraising to support SLA's work. Legally, it's important to be clear who the money raised is for.

Use our logo

Email enquiries@sla-india.org to let us know how you plan to use our logo and we will send you a copy. Always mention
'SLA registered Scottish Charity no. SC030516' on publicity material.

Food hygiene

If you serve or prepare food, food safety laws apply.
Check food.gov.uk to be on the safe side.

Whatever you plan, it's important your fundraising is safe and legal

Stay compliant

Look at the Code of Fundraising Practice -

fundraisingregulator.org.uk/code

- especially the section on Behaviour when fundraising.

Keep within the law

If you have a raffle and use cloakroom tickets, you must sell them and draw them on the day of the event.
